

# Love Your Neighbor Teaching Sessions

## **Session 1 – Why Love Your Neighbour?**

An introduction to reasons for this seminar, including biblical foundational attitudes

## **Session 2 – The Pizza**

Hinduism has been compared to a rain forest; we compare it to a pizza with three main ingredients and many toppings; awareness of the common features you will almost certainly encounter with your Hindu friends.

## **Session 3 – Crucial Skills #1 – Initiating Spiritual Conversations**

The first of three crucial skills for sharing Christ with Hindu friends; a three-part outline for spiritual conversations.

## **Session 4 – Crucial Skills #2 – Unlearning Christian Jargon**

Learning to express biblical thoughts and your personal experiences with Lord Jesus in fresh ways that don't confuse or put off your non-Christian friends.

## **Session 5 – Crucial Skills #3 – Overcoming Obstacles**

Remove the obstacles that Christians unwittingly put up, and some objections that Hindu people have to the gospel; practise responding to the most common 'tolerance conversation-stopper'.

## **Session 6 – Who Thinks What about Whom #1: What our Hindu Friends Think about Themselves**

First in a series of discussions based on articles about what Hindu people think. Read, discuss in a small group, and present to class one article; understand what our Hindu neighbours feel about their own religion and culture.

## **Session 7 – Who Thinks What about Whom #2: What our Hindu Friends Think about Christians**

Continuing series on what Hindu people think and feel about Christians with more articles and a video with discussion on the more extreme objections.

## **Session 8 – Who Thinks What about Whom #3: What Christians Think about Hindus**

This section contains articles as a resource and is not taught as a session.

## **Session 9 – The ABCDs of Going**

What does it mean to 'go' to our Hindu neighbours? Introducing the concept of contextualisation.

## **Session 10 – The Power of Story**

How to convey the gospel message in story form by learning what attracts our Neighbours to Lord Jesus.

## **Session 11 – Following Up Seekers and New Believers**

How to help a genuine seeker with individual and group discipleship, specially in the face of opposition.

## **Session 12 – Strategies That Work, Tools That Build Confidence**

Putting strategies and tools in your hands so that you may immediately practise what you have learnt.
