

JESUS Film App Witnessing

The *JESUS* film has been available on video and DVD for years. Multilanguage DVDs are great for distributing at large outreaches or giving away personally. Now the *JESUS* film products – every film in every language ever made – are available to stream or download through a free app for smart phones and iPads and on a website.

It's not just the full-length classic *JESUS* film. Also available are dozens of individual scenes, like Jesus raising Jairus' daughter, or calming the storm; Magdalena (women's version), children's version, discipleship episodes like "Rivka;" and short films on spiritual themes good for spiritual discussions. One of the most popular short films is "Broken Plates."

Getting the app

Go to your app store and search for the Jesus Film app. Then use the app to enhance your personal evangelism by sharing Christ in the heart language of people you meet easily and quickly.

Beginning a conversation using the app

Invite your friend to view a short video. You might use descriptive words like "spiritual" or thought-provoking" or even "funny" or "dramatic." Tell them you will want their opinion on it.



Engaging the person in a spiritual discussion

Watch the video together, get their opinions on it, their understanding of what they saw.

Five key questions

Ask these after any *JESUS* film clip or short film:

1. What did you like best about it?
2. Is there anything you didn't like?
3. What did you learn about Jesus (or God)?
4. What did you learn about people from the video?
5. What is one thing you think God may want you to do as a result of what you've seen in this video?

Concluding the witnessing opportunity

Ask to meet again to discuss the Bible, invite to church, give Bible tract or gospel portion, exchange contacts.
